

THE HAWKESBURY LADIES GOLF CLASSIC

TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The Hawkesbury Ladies Golf Classic will be played over fifty-four (54) holes in 3 Stableford rounds at Windsor, Lynwood & Richmond Golf Clubs.
2. A 54 Hole, 4BBB Competition will be run in conjunction.
3. Completed entry form/s & entry fee/s will be accepted in order of receipt. Late entries **may** be accepted if space available.
4. Divisions will be decided upon entries received.
5. A Ball Competition & or Pro Pin, will be run daily by the Pro Shop of each course.
6. Once entries have closed and the draw issued, no refunds will be made.
7. Draw Tee Times may be viewed on the internet; www.windsorgolfclub.com.au members – associates – draw sheets - a week prior to tournament - plus on each club web site.
8. If a Competitor reduces or increases her handicap, after the first round of the competition, her original handicap shall apply to the 54 hole event. Daily events will be decided on current handicap/s of the day.
9. A Presentation will take place daily, as soon as possible, after completion of each round.
10. In the event of a tie:-
 - a. Daily winners will be decided according to the rules of golf.
 - b. For the 54 hole event, a countback of the last– 18, 9, 6 & 3 holes will be performed, then hole by hole until a decision has been reached.
11. The order of prizes for winners/s of the daily & 54 Hole event/s will be:-

THE DAILY EVENT –

- a) Best Nett - in each division
- b) Scratch - over all divisions
- c) Nett Runner Up - in each division
- d) 2nd Nett Runner Up -in each division
- e) 4BBB Winners, Runners Up & 2nd Runners Up

NOTE *Daily winners are eligible to win only one **singles**, major prize per event, per day*

THE 54 HOLE EVENT –

- a) The best aggregate Nett score – in each division
- b) The best aggregate scratch score – over all divisions
- c) The best aggregate 4BBB Nett score
- d) The best Nett 54 Hole aggregate score -over all divisions - will win

12. Motorised Transport is allowed. The committee takes no responsibility for its availability.
13. Distance measuring devices may be used as long as they conform to Golf NSW guidelines.
14. Mobile phones may be carried, but must be switched off or in silent mode. They may be used in bona fide emergencies only.
15. The Rules of Golf plus the Local Rules and Temporary Local Rules displayed on the day, will be strictly enforced.
16. All disputes should be directed to the Match Committee as soon as possible after the completion of the round & prior to handing in the card/s. Players may refer to Rule 3-3 in stroke play. The Match Committee decision shall be final.
17. Competitors must be ready, at the tee, 15 minutes prior to their designated time in the draw. Lateness to the Tee will be dealt with under Rule 6-3a, at the Match Committee’s discretion.
