New Handicapping

The new handicapping system is now in operation, so be on the lookout for changes to your handicap. Golf Link will be responsible for calculating it, so always play to the handicap on the computer and your card. Look on the Golf Link website or ask Pam for more details if you wish.

New Divisions - 11th May

Due to falling numbers in Division 1, we are changing divisions in our club events to the following -

- Division 1— 0 to 25
- Division 2— 26 to 34
- Division 3— 35 to 45

This will make the numbers in each division more even.

1. Check if it is a local rule. Find the nearest point of relief where you can swing without hitting the tree and drop within one club length without penalty. If you hit the tree there is a penalty of two strokes.
2. No penalty if you are completing your swing.
3. If you bring down enough to improve your swing, there is a penalty of 2 strokes, so be careful!
4. If you think you cannot play it, you can take an unplayable lie. You may drop within two club lengths OR go back as far as you like along the line from the pin to your ball OR go back to where you originally hit it.
5. If the garden has an edging, you can take a free drop.
