Rules Quiz

True or False?

1. If a ball is lost or out of bounds, you play another ball from the spot where the original ball was played, with a penalty of one stroke.
2. You have 10 minutes to search for a ball before it is lost.
3. You must tell someone that you are playing a provisional ball before you hit it or else the second ball becomes the ball in play.
4. A player thinks her ball is lost and plays a provisional. She finds that her first ball is unplayable and decides to play the provisional. Is this correct?
5. You may play your provisional ball when you reach it, without looking for the original ball.
6. You can only play a provisional ball once before you have to decide which ball to play.
7. As soon as you go back to play another ball, the original ball is declared lost.
8. You cannot go back to the tee to play a provisional ball.
9. A ball on the boundary line is out of bounds.
10. You can play a provisional ball at Windsor on the 2nd, 7th and 8th holes if you think the ball is lost in the water hazard
