Penalty for Breach of a Local Rule unless otherwise specified in the Local Rules or the applicable Rule: General Penalty under the applicable Rule.

COVID-19 LOCAL RULES

- Players must enter their hole scores on their own scorecard (it is not necessary for a marker to do it). To do this:
 - Choose a notional marker.
 - o Confirm your score with the notional marker before playing from the next tee.
 - Record the notional marker's scores on your scorecard
 - Write the notional marker's name in the Marker signature box.
 - Your signature on your scorecard certifies that you have followed this procedure.
- Leave the flagstick in the hole at all times. The flagstick must not be touched.
 - Buffers have been placed into the cups to stop the ball from dropping to the bottom of the cup
- Bunker rakes have been removed from the course.
 - Please smooth bunkers using your feet or a club.
 - o If a bunker has not been sufficiently smoothed, you may take a preferred lie.

ADDITIONAL TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES

- Compulsory tee up through the green when not using a putter. Optional tee up through the green when using a putter.
 - Note 1: This rule does not allow the ball to be moved from the spot: it must be teed where it lay. Preferred lie is not available.
 - Note 2: Teeing up when chipping is especially important on the green surrounds where the new turf has not yet properly rooted. Tee up is to protect sensitive parts of the course from damage and will be reviewed weekly. If play is causing damage it may be necessary to close the course again.
- If your ball comes to rest in one of the bare patches on the green where the grass has not yet knitted together, it can be treated as being in GUR. Relief is available at the nearest point of complete relief no nearer the hole. Line of play relief is not available.

OTHER CONDITIONS

- Carts must keep to paths where provided. In other locations carts must generally keep to the rough and must not be driven along the fairway. When necessary to keep the game flowing, carts may cross fairways at right angles in places where turf is fully established and healthy. In wet weather, carts must avoid fairways.
- Only **one** person may use or ride in any cart unless both players are living together in the same household. Hire carts are available. No spectators or caddies are allowed.
- All play will be in groups of 2. This is irrespective of family or living arrangement.
- All competitions will be run according to Friday competition conditions.
- There will be no NTPS.
